2. <u>THEN</u>, fill out the Registration Form (attached) and give it with your payment to your Squadron Representative. Your Representative will then get the registrations to me, Sharon Neitzey, so I can pay with D23 funds. This will allow us to use our Tax-Exempt status, enabling you to avoid paying 22% taxes for the hotel and sales tax for food and activities. 
